TIER 1

- novelty
- acceleration
- depth
- complexity in instructional experiences; intensive in school field trips (Walkthroughs)
 - overnight field trips
- greater adult to student ratio
 - universal themes
 - project based learning
 - habits of mind

 - integrated GATE standards
- formal GATE testing begins in 2nd grade
 - open-ceiling activities
 - accountable talk

TIER 2

Intensive Workshop Time- students are planked across a grade level, for four 30 minute blocks per week to work on a projects and activities linked to a specific area passion/need



TIER 3

Individual students who are formally identified as gifted and talented have a individualized personalized plan with goals developed with teachers and parents each year, passion projects
